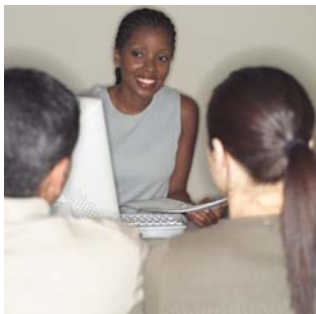
LEARN
