About the Youth Genesee Serves GYSD Opportunity

Youth Genesee Serves supports service projects which activate young people to be change-makers in their community. Each project is expected to:

- Work with a core group of youth (e.g. a club or a class) to lead a service project around an issue area that is important to the youth
- Engage other volunteers (peers, teachers, parents, community members) in the project
- Work with partners in the community to ensure the project meets a community need
- Inform United Way as to the details of the project so that we may come to observe, take photos, and help tell the story of the service project
- Use reflection throughout the project to help youth think about their role in community and their ability to positively impact their surroundings
- Seek donations (cash or in-kind) or use existing resources to support the projects
- Projects are expected to take place on or near April 12-14, 2019.
